

# CBA Captain (tested as CICA1521) – SA

## September 2021, prepared by NSW DPI

- CBA Captain<sup>(1)</sup> is a broadly adapted desi chickpea variety.
- CBA Captain<sup>(1)</sup> has a good height to lowest pod and good lodging resistance. These attributes combined provide excellent harvestability – far superior than current southern desi varieties.
- CBA Captain<sup>(h)</sup> is mid flowering and mid-maturing in SA growing environments. •
- CBA Captain<sup>®</sup> has been evaluated in SA NVT testing since 2015. Please see https://app.nvtonline.com.au for location specific yield data.
- CBA Captain<sup>()</sup> consistently yields higher than the site mean yield in NVT in the Mid-North and • Yorke Peninsula of SA.

### **Disease resistance**

- CBA Captain<sup>®</sup> has an NVT pulse disease rating for Ascochyta blight of Moderately Susceptible in the southern region. This is the same disease rating as Genesis<sup>™</sup> 090 and PBA Royal<sup>®</sup>. CBA Captain<sup>®</sup> has a higher NVT pulse disease rating for Ascochyta blight than Neelam<sup>®</sup>, PBA Slasher<sup>®</sup>, PBA Striker<sup>®</sup> and Genesis Kalkee which are all rated as Susceptible in the southern region
- CBA Captain<sup>(1)</sup> has an NVT pulse disease rating for Botrytis grey mould of Susceptible, the same as all other current chickpea varieties.

### **Grain quality**

- CBA Captain that a medium seed size with a yellow-brown seed coat and angular seed shape.
- The seed size of CBA Captain<sup>(1)</sup> would generally be smaller than PBA Striker<sup>(1)</sup> and similar in size to PBA Slasher<sup>(1)</sup> and Neelam<sup>(2)</sup>.
