

CBA Captain (tested as CICA1521) - Victoria

- CBA Captain is a broadly adapted desi chickpea variety.
- CBA Captain has a good height to lowest pod and good lodging resistance. These attributes combined provide excellent harvestability far superior than current southern desi varieties.
- CBA Captain is mid flowering and early to mid-maturing in Victorian growing environments.
- CBA Captain has been evaluated in Victorian NVT testing since 2017. Please see https://app.nvtonline.com.au for location specific yield data.

Disease resistance

- CBA Captain® has an NVT pulse disease rating for Ascochyta blight of Moderately Susceptible in the southern region. This is the same disease rating as Genesis™ 090 and PBA Roya® . CBA Captain® has a higher NVT pulse disease rating for Ascochyta blight than Neelam®, PBA Slasher®, PBA Striker® and Genesis Kalkee which are all rated as Susceptible in the southern region
- CBA Captain to has an NVT pulse disease rating for Botrytis grey mould of Susceptible, the same as all other current chickpea varieties.

Grain quality

CBA Captain has a medium seed size with a yellow-brown seed coat and angular seed shape.

In the Mallee and Wimmera regions of Victoria the seed size of CBA Captain would generally be similar in size to PBA Striker and larger than PBA Slasher and Neelam.
